The wienXtra holidaygame offers a kaleidoscope of leisure-time programmes for children in Vienna, guaranteed to turn holidays into exciting and stimulating adventure at a reasonable price.

For all children in Vienna

The wienXtra holidaygame is a programme of adventure and city fun for all children who spend their holidays in Vienna. Here is where they experience a wealth of thrills and stimulations while they play and tinker, discover and search, at the theatre, the cinema, the museum, at sports events and festivals. Holiday programmes are child-oriented, but festivals and big events are fun for all the family!

Adventure, fun and games!

The Vienna holidaygame is held every year, during the summer holidays, the winter holidays and the Vienna end-of-term break. "Holli Knolli", the Vienna holidaygame mascot, is an all time favourite. Shortly before schools in Vienna break up for any of the above holidays children from grade 1 to grade 7 receive their holidaygame-passes containing all the information on available activities. Included with the holidaygame-passes are registration cards for exciting holidaygame contests.

You want to know more about our holidaygame-pass?

During the winter holidays, the Vienna end-of-term break and the summer holidays wienXtra offers children's programmes which are published in a holiday-game pass for 6 to 10 year olds (grade 1 to 4) and a holiday-game pass for 10 to 13 year olds (grade 5 to 7).

For children who attend school in Vienna these holiday-game passes are distributed by their class teacher no later than one week before they break up. Make sure your child receives theirs in time!

Lost holiday-game passes will be replaced at the wienXtra children's information centre.

Please remind your child to take the holiday-game pass along to each activity so that they can participate free of charge in all the events marked "gratis". For other activities the special prices indicated are valid only in combination with a holidaygame-pass.

Why stamps? The holidaygame contest!

Each page of the holiday-game pass for 6 to 10 year olds depicts a Holli Knolli stamp which children receive for participating in the event published on that page. To participate in the holidaygame contest they have to collect several stamps and stick them in the holiday-game pass.

10 to 13 year olds also have a chance to win. To participate they need to fill in and send off the card attached to their holidaygame-pass!

A tip on the side: public transport in Vienna is free of charge for school children during holidays! Select an activity from the pass and find out which public line will get you there. Look up the online public transport schedule called: Fahrplan Abfrage der Wiener Linien (http://efa.vor.at/wvb/index_de.htm) if you can't find directions in the pass.

How do I find the holidaygame event of my choice?

Click „suche“ (search) on the left navigation bar and enter a search word, e.g. “tennis“.
All events whose descriptions contain your search word will show up, e.g. table tennis, taster tennis.
Please note! When you click the “search“ button the database will show all events held on that day and the following.

holidaygame registration

Registering made simple! Here is all the information you need to register.

Do I really need to register?!

There are plenty of activities you can attend at the spur of the moment without registering! For some, however, “registration is necessary!“ – either by phone with the organisation responsible or at the wienXtra-kinderinfo information centre.

There are three ways of registering at the wienXtra-kinderinfo information centre:

1. By phone at 4000 84 400
2. In person at the wienXtra-kinderinfo information centre. Please note: ticket sales are strictly without reservations and tickets will not be delivered by mail! To obtain a ticket you must register in person!
3. Via internet. The online form will be available from the first day of registration on!

A small request on our part: please let us know if your child/children is/are unable to participate in the activity they have registered for, or let a friend participate instead.

How do I register via internet?

One third of the places/seats available for each holiday-game event is reserved for phone registrations, one third for registrations in person and one third for internet registrations.

Click "mehr" (more) with the event of your choice to open a detail view of the activity. Where internet registration for the activity is possible the link "zum Anmeldeformular" (to register) will appear below the information on event dates.

Click the link to open a new window with the registration form.

Please complete the form. Select the date of your choice and press the button "abschicken" (send).

Your data are sent via e-mail to the team at the wienXtra-kinderinfo information centre and entered into the registration system. You will then receive a confirmation e-mail – your registration has been completed successfully!

If all available dates for the event of your choice are booked out you will receive the information: "this event is booked out - Diese Veranstaltung ist bereits ausgebucht!"

Where only some of the dates for the event have been deleted from the registration form you can try to register by phone or in person at the wienXtra-kinderinfo information centre.
